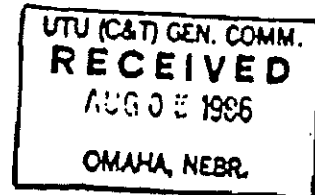

Dear Sir:

This is to confirm our conference of July 25, 1986, in which we discussed the filling of temporary vacancies at Green River.

During our conference, it was agreed all 13th District employees will be allowed to make application for temporary vacation vacancies on the Rock Springs switch engine.
